

ALL MAJOR AND MINOR 6TH INVERSIONS

The major and minor 6th chords can also be thought of as; for major 6th a minor third below the root would be the relative minor 7th chord. So for example c major 6th would also be an A minor 9. The minor 6th chord would have a relative half diminished chord a minor third below. For example c minor 6th would be A half diminished.
