

# CHROMATIC SCALE AND CHROMATIC PATTERNS

The chromatic scale and chromatic patterns are extremely useful in improvising. They can be used as a means to get us from one melody note to another, build tension and take us up and down the keyboard when improvising. Here we will be going over the scale as well as some patterns you may find helpful in your improvisation

First we will go over the chromatic scale in two octaves. follow the fingerings.


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
