

MAJOR MINOR AND DOMINANT SEVENTHS WITH INVERSIONS

The major 7 minor 7 and dominant 7 chords are the most frequently used seventh chords in music. For this reason it is important that the student be able to play these chords in every key and in every inversion. Later on when the student learns more about comping, they will be using these chords and inversions more frequently.

NOTE:some notes may be theoretically incorrect in order to make the exercise easier for the student to read









